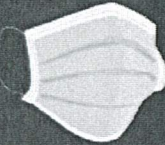




Multiple learning environments for 2020-2021

- In-Person Learning
- Blended Learning
- Safer-At-Home Learning

The SDMA will follow Governor Tony Evers orders in regards to face coverings.



Physical distancing will be considered when placing desks in classrooms, arranging seating for meals, and when students are lined up for transitions.

- In-Person Learning: Grades 4K-6 (at least 6 ft.) Grades 7-12 (at least 4 ft.)
- Blended Learning: Grades 4K-6 (at least 6 ft.)



Transportation will be offered to students, while still promoting mitigation strategies like hand sanitation, the use of cloth face coverings, physical distancing between students and cohort groupings when feasible. Families will be encouraged to transport children on their own if/when possible.



Breakfast and lunch will be offered to all students, while still promoting physical distancing between students and cohort grouping as much as practical. Food and drinks brought from home will be allowed for individual use in accordance with existing policies and school rules.



Monitor Health - Home symptom and exposure screening should be completed by all staff and students before leaving for school each day.



Cleaning and disinfecting has been increased in every building in accordance to the SDMA Reopening Plan. Hand sanitation stations will be available for all classrooms.



Building-level plans and procedures will be modified to further restrict school access for visitors. Safety protocols will be developed for necessary school visits and access to the schools by parents for both planned visits and emergencies.
